Information Provided by You

- **Payment Data:** Bank account details or payment method information.

Information Collected Automatically

- **Device and Technical Data:** IP address, device type, browser type, operating system, and location (based on your IP).
- **Website Usage Data:** Date and time of access, navigation history, and website preferences.

- Data from payment processors, trading platforms, or social networks if you link your account with us.

3. How Do We Use Your Personal Data?

We process your personal data for the following purposes:

Account Registration and Management

To register and manage your account, including verifying your identity and providing secure access.

- **Legal Basis:** Necessary for the performance of a contract.

Service Delivery

To provide trading platforms, tools, and customer support services.

- **Legal Basis:** Necessary for the performance of a contract or our legitimate interest.

Compliance with Legal Obligations

To comply with anti-money laundering (AML) laws, regulatory reporting, and other legal requirements.

- **Legal Basis:** Compliance with legal obligations.

Marketing

To send you relevant updates about our services or promotional content if you opt-in.

- **Legal Basis:** Consent or legitimate interest (for existing customers).

Service Improvement and Analytics

To enhance our services and optimize website functionality through customer behavior analysis.

- **Legal Basis:** Legitimate interest.

4. How Do We Store and Protect Your Personal Data?

Your personal data is stored securely using advanced encryption and access controls. We implement strict organizational and technical measures to prevent unauthorized access, alteration, or loss of data.

Data Retention Periods

- For contract performance: **10 years** from contract termination.
 - For marketing communications (without explicit consent): **5 years** after the last service contract or until you opt-out.
 - For legal compliance: As required by applicable laws (e.g., tax data for 10 years).

We may share your personal data with:

- Trading platform providers for service delivery.
- Third-party service providers (e.g., cloud storage, payment processors, IT support, marketing agencies).
- Regulatory bodies or authorities, as required by law.

All third-party recipients are contractually obligated to protect your data and process it per our instructions.

6. Do We Transfer Data to Third Countries or International Organizations?

If we transfer your personal data outside Saint Lucia or the European Economic Area (EEA), we ensure appropriate safeguards, such as standard contractual clauses or equivalent mechanisms, are in place to protect your data.

7. Your Rights

Under applicable data protection laws, you have the following rights:

- **Access:** Request a copy of your personal data and details about processing.
- **Rectification:** Correct inaccuracies in your data.
- **Erasure:** Request deletion of your data, subject to legal obligations.
- **Restriction:** Restrict processing in certain circumstances.
- **Data Portability:** Receive your data in a machine-readable format.
- **Objection:** Object to processing based on legitimate interest, including marketing.
- **Withdrawal of Consent:** Revoke consent for data processing at any time.

- **Complaint:** Lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority if you believe we have violated your data protection rights.
